



"Petit Dakar" 2026 – Rules

Considering that the "Petit Dakar":

- is an entirely non-competitive event; rather, it is an experience built on teamwork, solidarity, and empathy among participants and our hosts.
- the "race" (aside from the immeasurable one—to see who has the most fun, and brings home the richest treasure of memories...) is, in fact, a **generosity challenge!**

Morocco is experiencing an extraordinary period of economic and social development. However, in some remote regions—like the one we will visit—living conditions remain "archaic" compared to ours: certainly simpler and "poorer," but not necessarily less happy, judging by the bright eyes and warm smiles of the people.

For younger members of the population—children and adolescents—these conditions can be significantly improved by providing basic necessities (such as shoes to make getting to school easier or school supplies). These items are received with great joy and gratitude, making childhood less burdensome and allowing us to build invaluable bridges of friendship.

The purpose of this "generosity challenge" is to encourage the maximum collection of resources, not as mere charity but as an opportunity to gain insight into different ways of life.

This Regulation, with all its experimental and innovative aspects, aims to promote awareness and engagement.

We sincerely thank you in advance for any feedback or suggestions to improve it!

1) Objective

To reward the most generous participants, considering not only the amount of resources collected but also the impact and creativity of their initiatives.

2) Participation Requirements

Each participant must register by filling out the application form on the event's official website.

A pre-registration fee of at least €100 must be paid to "Bambini nel Deserto ETS" (<https://www.bnd.ngo/en/>) following the specified procedures.

The deadline for additional direct or indirect contributions is December 31, 2025.

3) Evaluation Criteria & Scoring

1) **Resources Collected** (70% of the total score):

- **Direct Contributions (Dc):** Funds personally raised by the participant.
1 point per euro
- **Indirect Contributions (Ic):** Funds collected through third parties (e.g., other donors).
1 point per euro, multiplied by 1.2

2) **Impact & Creativity (I&C)** (30% of the total score)

Assigned at the sole discretion of the jury based on:

- **Impact:** Number of beneficiaries reached, lasting effects, and significance.
- **Creativity:** Originality of the solutions adopted and their ability to inspire.

Final Score Formula:

$$P = Dc + (Ic \times 1.2) + I\&C$$

All activities eligible for points under the "Impact & Creativity" category must be documented by January 20, 2026, through a detailed report including:

- List of beneficiaries
- Description of the impact

- Presentation of the creative approach used

4) Awards

First Prize: based on the final ranking from section 3.

Special Creativity Award: for the most innovative idea.

Solidarity Award : for the participant who mobilized the most indirect resources.

5) Jury

The jury will be composed of a panel of individuals chosen at the sole discretion of the Petit Dakar Organizing Committee.
